Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, must be lodged at the meeting of the Branch Executive from 09:30 am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on Wednesday, 19 November 2025, until the close of nomination period, as per the announcement of the AEC Returning Officer at the meeting at Police Union Office, 217 North Quay, Brisbane.

Please note, a member of the electoral college who will not be in attendance at the Meeting, may advise the Returning Officer in writing, in advance of the Meeting, that they will stand as a candidate, and subject to their nomination being seconded by an attending Branch Executive Member, they will be a candidate in the election concerned. The nomination form must be lodged in the meeting.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify they meet all eligibility criteria set out in the organisation's rules, including financial status and any other necessary qualifications, before submitting their nominations.

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

In-Person: Before the nominations close at the meeting as announced by the Returning officer on 19 November 2025.

After nominations close and acknowledgment

After nominations close, all submissions will be reviewed to ensure they meet eligibility criteria and comply with the organisation's rules. If any issues are identified, the returning officer will notify the relevant candidates and provide a specific timeframe to remedy their nomination. Candidates will be informed of the outcome of these eligibility checks at the meeting.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after the close of nomination period at the meeting.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open and close on Wednesday 19 November 2025 at the meeting held at Police Union Office, 217 North Quay, Brisbane. The Returning Officer will advise the opening and closing times of the ballot at the meeting.

Scrutineer Appointment

A candidate may appoint a scrutineer. A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
